

EU BUDGET

The European Union has in fact a rather limited budget to serve 27 countries and 450 million people.



ADOPTING THE BUDGET

Adopted for 7 years, the EU budget follows a special procedure giving the EU member states most of the power:

1. The **European Commission** drafts the budget
2. EU leaders in the **European Council** provide political guidance
3. The **Council of the EU** (the national ministers of all EU countries) debates and unanimously agree
4. The **European Parliament** votes but can't modify the budget

Because the Council needs the Parliament's approval, negotiations still happen, but the Member States have the lead!



A few comparisons ...

With about **1.2 trillion euros** for 2021 to 2027, the EU budget looks big but is rather **small compared to its own member countries!**

It means each year :



€170 million for 450 million people



= Denmark's budget for 6 million people



= 10% of France's budget (€1.500 million in 2022) for 67 million people

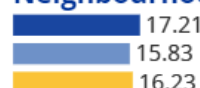

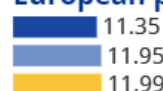
